

Traditional Time Line

TWELVE TO EIGHTEEN MONTHS

♥ Create a budget and discuss sharing of expenses
♥ Decide on the overall tone of your wedding: formal, semi-formal, informal
♥ Discuss color themes, design and decoration ideas, and music selection
♥ Select a wedding consultant
♥ Reserve location of ceremony
♥ Reserve location of reception
♥ Reserve location of rehearsal dinner
▼ Talk with parents about their financial assistance
♥ Begin researching your options
TWO TO SIX MONTHS
♥ Compile combined family's guest list
♥ Shop for wedding rings or begin to have rings designed
♥ Interview and select a caterer
♥ Shop and select gown, veil and accessories
♥ Select attendants' apparel
▼ Interview and select a photographer
 ▼ Interview and select a floral designer ▼ Schedule engagement photo session date
▼ Interview and select a videographer
▼ Select musicians and music for ceremony and reception
♥ Consult your travel agent about honeymoon plans
THREE TO SIX MONTHS
▼ Select and order men's formal wear
♥ Order invitations, personal stationery and wedding programs
♥ Professionally prepare and print map (include in invitation)
♥ Secure reservations and lodging for honeymoon
▼ Register gift preferences with two or more bridal registries
♥ Reserve rental items: candelabra, arches, linens, etc
♥ Reserve limousine, carriage, trolley or coach transportation
♥ Select make-up artist and begin skin care routine
♥ Reserve hotel rooms for out-of-town guest's
♥ Plan exercise program in your routine
♥ Sample and order wedding cakes



SIX TO EIGHT WEEKS

♥ Send local newspaper wedding announcement/photograph
♥ Shop for trousseau wardrobe for honeymoon, party's
♥ Mail invitations
♥ Plan attendants' gifts; gifts for each other
♥ Review and finalize floral and decorating arrangements
♥ Experiment with hairstyles and make-up with veil/hat
♥ Select ceremony accessories: unity candle, ring pillow, etc
♥ Select reception decorations: balloons, candles, etc
♥ Confirm all professional services in writing
♥ Schedule physical exams and update immunizations
♥ Select photos for your video montage
♥ Select your flower preservationist
▼ Final gown fitting Date:
♥ Final attendants' fitting Date:
TWO TO FOUR WEEKS
♥ Schedule appointments for manicure, pedicure, facial, massage
▼ Mail invitations for rehearsal dinner
♥ Send activity information to out-of-town guest's
♥ Schedule bridal portrait (remember make-up artist) Date:
♥ Make reservations for bridesmaids' brunch/luncheon
♥ Confirm honeymoon reservations, select luggage
♥ Record gifts as you receive them; write thank-you notes
♥ Schedule final appointments for hair stylist and make-up artist
♥ Confirm time and wedding rehearsal schedule with everyone
♥ Review reception seating; order place cards/calligrapher
♥ Confirm wedding party transportation and arrival times
♥ Confirm lodging for out-of-town guest's
▼ Arrange for professional gown and bouquet preservation
♥ Arrange name/address changes on bank account, credit cards, driver's license, social security and
utilities ▼ Secure marriage license
ONE TO TWO WEEKS
♥ Pick up wedding rings; check sizes and engravings
 ♥ Pick up wedding rings; check sizes and engravings ♥ Final consultations with wedding consultant, florist, musicians, photographer, videographer,
decorators, rental company, etc
▼ Final guest count to reception facility and caterer
♥ Remind men to pick up formal wear/shoes and check for fit
♥ Complete a wedding day schedule, including schedule from photographer; give everyone a copy at
rehearsal dinner
♥ Pack for your honeymoon
♥ Your planning is complete. Relax!!



Ninety Day Timeline

NINETY DAYS OR MORE

♥ Select date
(Have backup dates in mind, and be prepared to be flexible in case the site, caterer, or officiant is already booked)
▼ Set budgetEstablish your priorities. Ask for written estimates as you speak with vendors.
♥ Reserve your ceremony, reception and rehearsal dinner sites
Select an officiant for your ceremony
Select wedding rings
♥ Hire wedding coordinator
▼ Compile a guest list
♥ Choose attendants and members of bridal partyConfirm their availability.
♥ Order gown and accessories including veil, gloves and shoes Followed shortly by selecting your bridesmaids' dresses
♥ Gift Registration
♥ Interview: Caterer
Photographer
Videographer
Florist
Bakery
Entertainment



SIXTY DAYS

♥ Invitations
Select quickly and confirm every detail in writing. Try to mail out to your guests 4-6 weeks prior to your wedding. Consider having your guest's phone or email for your RSVP.
♥ Select the food and beverage for the reception
♥ Plan and book honeymoon Don't forget to consider where you want to spend your first night together after the wedding.
♥ Reserve accommodations for out-of-town guest's
♥ Select site for rehearsal dinner and bridesmaids' luncheon or brunch
▼ Select Photographer Schedule appointment for engagement and bridal portrait photo shoot. Videographer Florist Bakery Entertainment Limo or transportation Makeup artist and hair stylist
THIRTY DAYS
▼ Meet with officiant and select music and reading for ceremony
♥ Determine rehearsal times
♥ Final dress fitting
♥ Photo shoot for bridal portrait and engagement
▼ Marriage license
▼ Send wedding announcements to newspaper
♥ Shop for gifts for the bridal party, parents and spouse
♥ Select and order men's apparel
♥ Purchase ceremony accessories: quest book and pen, ring bearer's pillow, etc.



TWO WEEKS

♥ Buy stockings, garter and any necessary special lingerie
▼ Arrange seating plans and write place cards
♥ Confirm details with all the vendors
♥ Confirm travel arrangements
♥ Confirm lodging for out-of-town guest's
♥ Complete programs – include map to reception site if necessary
♥ Write thank-you notes as you receive gifts
♥ Write announcements
♥ Break in bridal shoes
◆ Arrange for professional gown and floral preservation
ONE WEEK
♥ Notify caterer of final guest count
♥ Wrap gifts for bridal party
♥ Pack for honeymoon
♥ Have facial or any other beauty treatments
♥ Bridesmaids' luncheon
♥ Assign different responsibilities to bridal party, such as handing out corsages and boutonnieres,
programs and other necessary details
♥ Complete a wedding day schedule for vendors and bridal party
♥ Make arrangements for someone special to take home your wedding gifts and preserve the top of your cake for your first anniversary
ONE TO TWO DAYS BEFORE
♥ Men pick up tuxedos
▼ Manicure and pedicure
▼ Rehearse ceremony
♥ Enjoy rehearsal dinner
